YOUNTVILLE ARTS COMMISSION

The Town of Yountville is seeking one (1) community volunteer to fill an unexpired term on the Yountville Arts Commission. The term of office will commence February 7, 2017 and will expire on July 16, 2018. The Art Commission provides vision, leadership, inspiration and support to artists and their art in Yountville. The Arts Commission serves in an advisory capacity to the Town Council and staff in matters pertaining to the cultural arts, including, but not limited to the development of visual, performing and literary arts and other matters as may be referred to the Commission by the Town Council or Town Manager.
