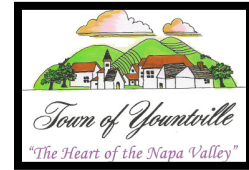


SPRING COMMUNITY YARD SALE & CLEAN-UP DAYS

Yard Sale, Saturday, May 9th: By participating in this event you not only get rid of the things that keep your car from being parked in the garage you also help the environment by recycling through the sale of unwanted items, thus lowering the amount of materials that may end up in the landfill. To participate in the yard sale all you have to do is call Community Service 944-8712 or send your address & times of your sale to news@yountvillesun.com no later than Tuesday, May 5th.



Clean up Day, Saturday, May 16th: One week later a special curbside pickup provided by the Town via a contract with Upper Valley Disposal will be conducted. Residents may place bagged and boxed trash, and other household items curbside. Most items will be picked up free of charge!

Please note the following when setting out items:



No hazardous waste materials may be included in this pickup. They will not pick up hazardous wastes, car parts, tires, and electrical items.



Boxes and bags are limited to 35 pounds each in weight.



Recyclable items (including cardboard) WILL NOT be picked up and should be disposed of during regular weekly curbside pick up.



Tire, appliances and larger items should be arranged to be picked up in advance with Upper Valley Disposal at 963-7988. There is a fee required for the pick up of large items.
