**Subject:** Path along Hopper Creek to be closed for Tree Work Scheduled to begin  
March 14, 2011

On Monday, March 14, Britton Tree Service of St. Helena is scheduled to begin a Town project to prune 23 trees along the path south and west side Hopper Creek from Yount Street to Finnell Road. The path will be closed during the work and the Town Arborist will inspect the work. The project is scheduled to be completed by March 18.

Gates and permanent signs are also being installed so that a portion of the path under the Heritage Oak tree behind the Hopper Creek Condominiums can be closed during storms. The tree is checked by the Town Arborist every six months and pruning will be done when recommended.
