The American Public Works Association proclaims the third week of May each year as National Public Works Week to recognize the people who devote their professional time and energy to public works, making communities better and safer places to live.

On May 17, John F. Dunbar, Mayor of the Town of Yountville, proclaimed the week of May 15 to 21 as “**National Public Works Week**” in The Town of Yountville, and called upon all citizens and civic organizations to acquaint themselves with the issues involved in providing our public works and to recognize the contributions that public works staff make every day to our health, safety, comfort, and quality of life.
