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**Subject:** 2011 Street Maintenance Project Approved

The Town Council approved the bid documents for the 2011 Streets Maintenance Project at their May 17 meeting. The project will be advertised to bidders and construction could begin in mid-August. Several private development and utility projects have been completed recently, so several streets will be overlaid with asphalt concrete. The Town also has a Pavement Management Program for scheduling maintenance projects and a Sidewalk Management Program to prioritize locations for sidewalk replacement. The project is funded with gas tax revenue and includes the following work:

1. Overlay Washington Street between the Yountville Inn Expansion and California Drive.
2. Overlay Mulberry Street south of the Community Center.
3. Overlay portions of Finnell Road in front of the Arroyo Grande Villas Affordable Housing Project
4. Overlay Vista Drive south of Finnell Road.
5. Place a cape seal on North Washington Street from Madison Street to Hopper Creek, which will reduce deterioration from numerous utility trench cuts.
6. Slurry seal Forrester Lane, Redwood Drive, Foxglove Lane, Jasmine Street and the eastern portion of Lande Way in Washington Park, which will help protect the existing pavement.

7. Construct traffic calming curb bulb outs into Mulberry Street east of the Community Center.
8. Construct a new concrete path from the west side of Washington Street at the realigned Champagne Drive to the path around the bocce courts.
9. Replace the wood curb and asphalt concrete path on the west side of Washington Street from Hopper Creek to Ma(i)sonry at Pedroni Street with a concrete curb, gutter and sidewalk.
10. Construct a 65 foot length of new sidewalk on the west side of Washington Street and north of Mulberry Street.
11. Remove and replace uplifted curbs, gutters and sidewalks on various Town streets.
