Subject: STREET LIGHT REPLACEMENT PROJECT SCHEDULED TO BEGIN ON
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 26, 2011

On September 26, Cats4U, Inc. of Healdsburg is scheduled to begin street light installations in the Town of Yountville, more specifically at the following locations:

1. Washington Street between California Drive and Yount Street
2. Yount Street between Washington Street and Finnell Road
3. Finnell Drive between Yount Street and Ghirardi Place
4. Oak Circle

The construction will consist of installing new street lights, removing existing street lights, and minor sidewalk and landscape repair around the street lights. The contract amount is \$116,884 for the construction of all areas of the project.

The Contractor will follow all Town rules pertaining to construction days and working hours and will maintain access to all business and residents through at least one access point. There will be traffic control measures in the areas indicated above with at least one lane of traffic open at all times.

Beginning September 26, the contractor will set up and begin work on Washington Street. The project should be completed by November 11, in time to prepare for the Festival of Lights on November 25. This project is part of the 2011-12 Town of Yountville Capital Improvement Program and is funded by the General Fund.
