Subject: Sidewalk and Traffic Calming Project 2011

On Tuesday, January 3, 2012, Team Ghilotti is scheduled to begin a Town project install new curb, gutter and sidewalks at the following locations in Town:

1. Replace existing sidewalk along the west side of Washington Street from Hopper Creek to Burgundy Way.
2. Replace a portion of the existing sidewalk and install tree well grates along the west side of Washington Street from Mulberry Street to Yount Street (in front of the Whistle Stop).
3. Replace portions of uplifted curb, gutter, and sidewalks on Vineyard Circle, Vista Court, Finnell Road, Heather Street, Oak Leaf Court, and Yount Street.
4. Construct a new sidewalk, a new pedestrian ramp, and an ADA accessible picnic table at the Veterans Memorial Park from Champagne Drive to the path around the Bocce Courts.

The Project will install new curb and gutter "bulb outs" in the parking spaces on the north and south side of Mulberry Street at the east end of the Community Center property as traffic calming measure.

On the week of January 3, the contractor will set up and begin work. The project should be completed by the end of January, weather permitting.

This project is funded by the Capital Improvement Fund and Gas Tax Revenue, and has a contract amount of \$86,421.60. If you have any questions, please contact Rob Urmini, Inspector, at 948-2631 or Graham Wadsworth, Public Works Director / Town Engineer at 944-8851, who is supervising this work.
