Subject: North Yountville Bike Route Project

The Town of Yountville has been awarded a \$200,000 Transportation Enhancement Grant to design and construct a safe bike route from Madison Street at Highway 29 to Yountville Cross Road at the eastern Town Limit. On Thursday, **April 19 at the 6 PM**, the project plans will be presented to the Parks & Community Services Commission at the Yountville Town Hall at 6550 Yount Street. The public is invited to provide input on the potential impact to Yountville Community Park users and the traveling public.

The main parts of the project are signing and striping along Madison Street, one block of Yount Street, and Yountville Cross Road. The project also includes a "spur" of the multiuse path from the Madison at Washington intersection to the restrooms at Yountville Community Park. The "spur" includes a concrete path around the south and west side of Picnic Area 3 (south end of Park), and striping along Washington Street and one block of Lincoln Avenue.

This proposed route segment will connect to the first segment of the Napa Valley Vine Trail along Highway 29 and will improve safety by allowing bike riders and pedestrians to use an Americans with Disabilities Accessible path between the Veterans Home and Yountville Community Park.
