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Subject: Slurry Seal Project on Various Streets Scheduled for Tuesday, April 28, 2009

On Tuesday, April 28, 2009, Bond Blacktop is scheduled to perform a major capital improvement project for the Town on Webber and Starkey Streets, Yountmill Road and a portion of Oak Circle. Slurry sealing will protect and extend the service life of the street, improve safety, and provide a smooth crack free surface.

While access to all residences will be maintained during the 1 or 2 day duration of the project, there will be inconveniences to those residents and the public who use either street in their cars, on their bikes or on foot.

"Repairing the street in front of one's house is always an inconvenience and we ask for the resident's patience with the contractor during the performance of this work" explained Myke Praul, Public Works Director/Town Engineer. "Town staff will be working closely with the contractor to make this inconvenience as bearable as possible for the public."

This project is the second phase of the Slurry Seal and Pavement Repair Program for 2008 and the contract amount is \$19,213.78.
