The Town of Yountville announces the opening of the application period for private, non-profit grant organizations based in Napa County **demonstrating a clearly identifiable benefit to Yountville residents**. Verification of non-profit status must accompany the application in the form of an approved IRS 501(c)3 or State of California non-profit certificate.

Please be advised that due to the current economic climate, funding is subject to availability and will be determined during the upcoming Town Council Budget Work Sessions which will take place during the Non-Profit Grant Funding Application period.

The Town Council recognizes and appreciates the support of private, not-profit programs which enhance the quality of life for Yountville residents.

Presentations from non-profit groups requesting funding are tentatively scheduled for the June 2, 2009 Council Meeting and final funding, if approved, shall occur in conjunction with adoption of the Town Council Budget for Fiscal Year 2009-2010. Applicants will be notified if it is determined that there will be no funding provided this fiscal year.
