

## Upcoming Town Improvements

Oak Circle Park Neighborhood Park (see picture) -- Beginning in January through March 2016, the Town will be providing exciting upgrades at Oak Circle Park! We'll be adding sitting areas, additional parking, bike racks and beautiful drought tolerant plants. This is a passive park and will be an excellent place to relax and reflect in this quiet area!



Yountville Community Park-- Beginning the first week of February in 2016, we will be improving ADA accessibility in the picnic areas with a stable surface. Planting areas will create buffers between picnickers and Lincoln Avenue as well as the recently constructed walkway along the west side. New plants and trees will offer interest and variety. The plants will be low enough to allow visibility throughout the park.
