Park Project Updates

Vineyard Park:

The Town is adding ADA accessible walkways to the basketball court on two sides as well as making the picnic area ADA accessible. All work is being completed by your friendly Town of Yountville Public Works crew.

Oak Circle Park: After some delays due to the rainy weather, drip irrigation for the drought tolerant plants yet to come was installed in late February.

Yountville Community Park:

The picnic area project renovation is close to complete! The TerraPave picnic areas have been laid out and base rock placed on the large picnic area. The 18 4" diameter 20 foot tall October Glory Maples were planted in February! The Park will fully reopen for Easter Weekend.



Did You Know?

Did you know that construction activity that creates noise is not permitted on a holiday?

Town-observed holidays include Dr. Martin Luther King's Birthday, President's Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Veterans' Day, Thanksgiving and the Friday following Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day. If any of the preceding holidays occurs on a weekend day, then the prior Friday if on a Saturday or the following Monday if on a Sunday shall be defined as the holiday. If you observe work on a holiday, since Town Hall offices will be closed, please contact the Town Sheriff at 944-9228. The Sheriff will attend to the complaint and ensure that the work site is closed.
