They will also have the chance to provide feedback on potential policies the Town could include in its new Climate Action Plan. The Go Green Team is a committee consisting of five council-appointed resident members and two members of the Yountville Town Council. They meet regularly on the fourth Tuesday of each month at 4:30 p.m. at Yountville Town Hall.

Their purpose is to develop a Climate Action Plan to guide the Town's efforts to reduce greenhouse gas emissions in the community and within government operations over the next five years. Members learn about sources of greenhouse gas emissions in the energy, transportation, water, wastewater, waste, and natural systems sectors, and work to develop Yountville's emission reduction strategies and programs with technical assistance from a number of agencies and organizations.
