Resolution Number 16-3364

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF YOUNTVILLE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT TO THE OFFICE(S) OF COUNCILMEMBER(S) OF THE TOWN THAT WERE NOMINATED TO BE ELECTED ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 2016 AT THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION AND THE SPECIAL ELECTION AND TO CANCEL SAID ELECTIONS

Recitals

- A. On June 7, 2016, the Town Council adopted Resolution No. 16-3339, which called and ordered to be held in the Town of Yountville, California, on Tuesday, November 8, 2016 a General Municipal Election for the purpose of electing two (2) Council Members of the Town Council to serve the full four-year term of office ("General Municipal Election");
- B. On June 21, 2016, the Town Council adopted Resolution No. 16-3354, which called for and gave notice of a Special Election to be held on the same date and at the same time as the Statewide General Election to be held on November 8, 2016 for the purpose of electing one (1) Council Member to fill a vacancy and to serve for the remaining two years of that office ("Special Election");
- C. Pursuant to California Elections Code section 10229, as of the close of the nomination period on Friday, August 12, 2016 for both the General Municipal Election and the Special Election, there are not more candidates than offices to be elected and one of the following courses of action may be taken by the Town Council:
 - 1. Appoint to the office the person who has been nominated.
 - 2. Appoint to the office any eligible voter if no one has been nominated.
 - 3. Hold the election if either no one or only one person has been nominated.
- D. For the General Municipal Election for the purpose of electing two (2) Council Members of the Town Council to serve the full four-year term of office, the candidates are Marjorie Mohler and Jeffrey Durham;
- E. For the Special Election for the purpose of electing one (1) Council Member to fill a vacancy and to serve for the remaining two years of that office, the candidate is Kerri Dorman;
- F. There are no other Town Offices to be filled and no Town Ballot Measure has qualified for either the General Municipal Election or the Special Election;
- G. On August 16, 2016, the Town Clerk posted notice of these facts and the courses of action available as required by California Elections Code section 10229;
- H. On August 12, 2016, the Town Clerk posted and submitted a certificate of these facts to the Town Council as required by California Elections Code section 10229.

Now, therefore, the Town Council of the Town of Yountville does resolve as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to California Elections Code section 10229, the following persons are hereby appointed to the office for which they were nominated for the following terms:

NAME	OFFICE	TERM
Marjorie Mohler	Member of the Town Council	Four Years
Jeffrey Durham	Member of the Town Council	Four Years
Kerri Dorman	Member of the Town Council	Two Years

2. The person(s) appointed by this Resolution, if any, shall qualify and take office and serve exactly as if elected at a municipal election for the office.
3. By adopting this Resolution and making the appointments in Section 1 above, the General Municipal Election and Special Election to be held on November 8, 2016 are hereby cancelled.
4. The Town Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.


