Subject: ADA Sidewalk Trip Hazard Repair to Begin Monday October 10, 2016

On Monday October 10, 2016 through approximately Wednesday October 13, the Town will be removing tripping hazards on select sidewalks as part of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) sidewalk program and to provide a safer pedestrian experience. The work will occur from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. by Precision Concrete Cutting. The process will ensure that the sidewalks are safe and ADA compliant by eliminating tripping hazards.

This work will occur on Yount Street and in neighborhoods including the area around Mulberry Street and Oak Circle, but work will occur throughout other areas of Town based on the rotating survey schedule.

This will not impact parking, but pedestrians may have to walk around the sidewalks while the work is occurring. Thank you for your patience as we continue to make our sidewalks safe! This project is in its final year, and will begin a new cycle next year of surveying sidewalks that may need repair.
