Subject: Yountville Mayor Dunbar and Councilmember Dorenbecher appointed to leadership positions with the League of California Cities

Yountville Mayor John Dunbar and Councilmember Marita Dorenbecher were named to leadership positions in the League of California Cities at the organization's annual conference last week in Long Beach.

Dunbar was elected by the organization's statewide Board to represent the cities and towns of the North Bay Division, which is one of 16 regional divisions in the State and comprises 31 cities in Napa, Marin, Sonoma and Solano counties. The statewide Board is responsible for the overall supervision, control, and direction of the League.

"I look forward to serving on the Board of Directors and thank the North Bay membership for their confidence in me as I assume this new role. As Director, I will continue to engage directly with our State legislators and other local government officials to better serve all of our residents and communities. The League Board is a valuable source for collaboration both locally and statewide as we all learn from other cities and towns dealing with common issues," Dunbar said.

Dorenbecher was appointed Chair of the Community Services Policy Committee by League President JoAnne Mounce. She has served on that committee the past four years.

"I am proud to be representing Yountville on the League of California Cities Community Services Policy Committee and honored to be named Chair of this Committee," Dorenbecher said.

Dunbar served as President of the North Bay Division in 2011-12 and is a member of the Division's Executive Leadership Committee. He has been an active participant in League activities since 2005. Dorenbecher has been involved with the League since joining the Town Council in 2010.

Established in 1898, the League of California Cities is a nonprofit statewide association that advocates for cities and towns with the State and federal governments and provides education and training services to elected and appointed city officials and staff.
