Marker replacement - Yountville Pioneer Cemetery

 - a. The objective is to replace wood grave site markers and non-existing markers on gravesites at the YPC. Currently there are wood grave markers that are deteriorating, illegible, and/or no longer existing.
 - b. The second objective is to mark the sites with the Name birth and death date to mark the site of their remains and to remember the deceased who are buried at the YPC.
 - c. The third objective is to honor and respect our fellow citizens who may not have living family members that can replace markers. The Board members feel that it is important to keep a record of the citizens buried there. These people are a part of our local history.
