



Coronavirus, Social Distancing, and Shelter-in-Place:

What does it mean for my construction project in Yountville?

On March 20, 2020, the Governor of California issued a “Safer-at-Home” (shelter-in-place) order to all the state’s residents. This means that many nonessential businesses have temporarily closed and residents throughout the state have been encouraged to remain indoors and away from other people to prevent the spread of the virus. BY APPOINTMENT ONLY

Town Hall is still open for business, but if you want to talk to a Planner or the Building Inspector in person about your project, an appointment is required. Please call Town Hall at (707) 944-8851 to arrange one.

REDUCED BUILDING INSPECTION HOURS

Due to lower demand, building inspections are now offered on Mondays and Wednesdays between 1pm and 4pm only. To schedule an inspection, please email inspections@yville.com or call the inspection request line at (707) 948-2606.

PERMITS STILL BEING PROCESSED

Permit applications for construction projects, vacation rentals, tree removals, home occupations, and others are still being processed and Planners are ready to help you. Please call (707) 944-8851 to inquire about any permits.

CHANGES TO PLAN SUBMITTAL PROCESS

Plan sets are still being accepted, though the process has changed. Please see the “Electronic Plan Submittal Instructions” and “In Person Plan Submittal Instructions” handouts posted on the Applications & Forms webpage.
